Starting from March 12, 2022

Basic sanitary measures



If you have symptoms, stay home



Frequent hand washing



Wear a face covering when required

Ski lodge	To circulate, the face covering is mandatory inside the ski lodge for people aged 10 and over. Venue capacity for the ski lodge at 100 %.
Restaurants, bars and lunch areas	Bars and restaurants open at 100 % of their capacity, normal opening hours. No maximum people per table. The face covering is mandatory in order to circulate.
Services (ski shop, rentals, lockers)	The face covering is mandatory in the indoor spaces for people aged 10 and over.
Ski lifts	Visitors from the same household are encouraged to ride the lift or gondolas together. In the lift lines and while riding the lift, the face-covering or a balaclava/neck warmer covering both mouth and nose is recommended. Inside the gondolas, the mask or face covering is mandatory.
Ski and snowboard schools and racing clubs	Ski and snowboard lessons as well as racing club activities are permitted. The face covering* is recommended. *It can be a balaclava or neck warmer covering both mouth and nose.
